OVERVIEW

What will be taught on the course?

In this course you will discuss and learn about what is halal (permissible) and haram (prohibited) for a Muslim in our everyday lives. You will learn about matters of halal and haram concerning foods, earnings, mortgages, credit cards, clothing, hijab, betting, manners, etiquettes and many other related issues.

What are the expected learning outcomes?

During the course, we expect students to:-

- Learn about the meanings of the concepts of halal and haram.
- Learn about what is halal for a Muslim in our everyday lives in a wide range of areas.
- Learn about what is haram for a Muslim in our everyday lives in a wide range of areas.

How long is the course?

The course is 10 weeks long, with 1 class taking place every week. Each class is 2 hours.

How will the course be delivered?

The course will be delivered live and online using Zoom.
